





















## SUB-PROGRAMME MANICA PROVINCE

DELPAZ is a Mozambique government programme funded by the European Union and supported by the Italian Agency for Development Cooperation (AICS) together with its partners, a consortium of civil society organisations led by Helpcode.

AICS is implementing a local economic development activity, understood as a key element to contribute to local peace and reconciliation, through support to productive activities and food security and the improvement of local infrastructure in a socially and gender inclusive perspective, working together with local institutions and community members in five districts of Manica Province to promote lasting and sustainable change for communities affected by the conflict.

In the Báruè district, DELPAZ works in the following communities: Sanhandundzi, Mussianharo, Catolé, Nhabuto, Chiuala, Nhamatema, Inhazonia, Nfudzi, Nhamadjiua. In Gondola district, DELPAZ works in the following communities: Muda serração, Mudima, Ingomai, Amatongas, Gouidione,

In the Guro district, DELPAZ works in the following communities: Sanga, Thoa, Nhamassonge, Massangano, Nhacatale, Mandei sede, Mungare, Chivuli , Bunga, Guro sede, Minga.

In the Macossa district, DELPAZ works in the following communities: Nhamagua, Dunda, Macossa sede, Nhacassoro, Massenguere, Kasbet, Nhamatica, Nguawala. In the district of Tambara, DELPAZ works in the following communities: Chiuta, Casado, Nhacafula, Ngondonga, Nhabote, Sachinda, Sabeta sede, Miteme, Nhamalema, Nhadota, Buzua-Sede.

## Activities

Construction rehabilitation of small-scale public infrastructure, both for civil use (wells) and for productive use (animal treatment corridors, road district rehabilitation. rehabilitation, market warehouses for agricultural use).



Direct support to 1703 smallholder farmers with seed distribution, technical

training through the installation of demonstration fields, creation of multiplication fields for food support for the most vulnerable, irrigation infrastructure, creation of a district 'Green Point' managed by a farmers' association geared towards processing and marketing.

Community-based and capacity-building trainings for local institutions in the areas of gender equality and women's empowerment, financial education (including for business management), community



infrastructure management, social inclusion, also in collaboration with community radio.
